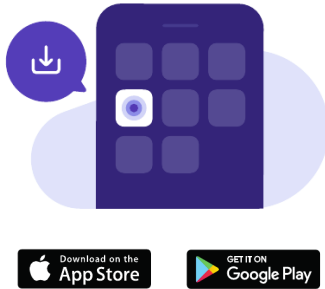


Get online in 6 simple steps

5G Home Broadband

1 Download the Nokia WiFi app



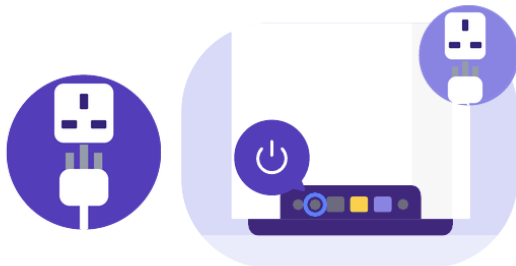
Before plugging anything in, search for Nokia WiFi on the App Store or Google Play and install the free app. It will guide you through setup.

2 Choose the right spot



Place your gateway near a window with few obstructions and a power socket nearby. Your SIM card is already installed — there is nothing to insert.

3 Power on



Connect the power adapter and press the power button. The light blinks while the gateway searches for the best 5G signal — this can take a few minutes.

4 Check the status light



Green or yellow means you are connected and good to go. Red means the signal is weak — power off and move the gateway higher or closer to a window, then try again.

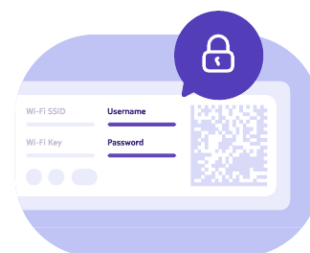
5 Pair the app with your gateway



Open the Nokia WiFi app and follow the setup steps. When asked, use the scanner inside the app to scan the QR code on the bottom of your gateway.

! The QR code only works from inside the Nokia WiFi app — scanning it with your phone camera won't do anything.

6 Connect your devices



Join the Wi-Fi network using the network name (SSID) and Wi-Fi key printed on the label on the bottom of your gateway. You can rename your network or change the password in the app.
